DAD'S DAY ACTIVITIES SCHEDULED FOR FINAL GRIZZLY HOME GAME

MISSOULA---

The University of Montana Grizzlies hope to wrap up their home schedule for 1968 in winning fashion Saturday when they take on the Weber State College Wildcats in a game honoring fathers of 1968 Grizzly gridders.

The main event of Dad's Day will of course be the football game at 1:30 p.m. on Dornblaser Field, but other plans have been made for visiting fathers.

A Century Club breakfast honoring all fathers in attendance will be held at 8"30 a.m. Saturday in the Florence Hotel. The breakfast is open to non-Century Club members as well, and will serve as a pep rally for the afternoon contest.

Johnson's Flying Service, which transports Grizzly teams to road games in football and basketball, will provide free helicopter tours of the UM campus for all visiting fathers.

The Dads will sit in on the pre-game pep talk by Coach Jack Swarthout in the Grizzly locker room, will sit on the bench with the team during the game, and will be individually introduced at halftime.

Transportation to and from lodging to the ball game and other activities will be provided for player's fathers during the day by Century Club members.

The Grizzlies, 2-5 for the season and 0-3 in the Big Sky Conference, have an opportunity to spoil Weber State's bid for a three-way share of the league title with a victory over the Wildcats Saturday.

Weber State, nationally ranked among the nation's small colleges since the season began, picked up its first loss of the season last Saturday in Moscow, Idaho in a 50-42 free-for-all loss to Idaho.

DAD'S DAY--2--

Montana blew a 24-9 lead over arch-rival Montana State and dropped a 29-24 decision to the gritty Bobcats Saturday in Missoula. The Grizzlies seemingly had the game on ice before a Bobcat blitz erased the apparent victory in the final 12 minutes of the game.

Junior tailback Mike Buzzard of Mt. Vernon, Wash. picked up 77 yards against the Cats to move into the Grizzly rushing lead. He has now picked up 316 yards on 71 carries, a 4.5-yard average. He also leads the team in kickoff returns with 286 yards on 13 runbacks, a 22-yard average.

Junior quarterback Ray Brum continues to lead Grizzly passing and total offense statistics. The Honolulu, Hawaii junior has thrown for 650 yards, and has 588 yards in total offense.

Jim Kelly, senior tight end from Seattle, Wash., is now the leading Grizzly pass receiver with 14 grabs for 223 yards. Junior split end Al Luis of Orland, Calif. is close behind with 13 catches for 217 yards.

Sophomore place kicker Dan Worrell of Great Falls scored six points against Montana State to run his season total to 42, 18 more than second-place scorers Ron Baines of Tacoma, Wash. and John McBurrows of Englewood, N.J. with 24 each. Worrell has hit on 21 of 22 extra point kicks and 7 of 9 field goals.

In team statistics, the Grizzlies trail their opponents in first downs, 121-114; passing yardage, 1,243-935, and points scored, 189-180.

The Silvertips lead their foes in net rushing yardage, 1,636-1,354, and in total offense, 2,382-2,335.

Following their game with Weber State, the Tips will wrap up the 1968 season in Flag-staff, Ariz. Nov. 16 against always-tough Northern Arizona University.
