U ARTIST'S WORK IS SHOWN IN SALT LAKE

Mrs. Maxine M. Blackmer of the University of Montana art faculty is among some 40 craftsmen in the region represented in the 1968 Intermountain Crafts Exhibition at the Salt Lake City, Utah, Art Center.

Three pieces of jewelry by Mrs. Blackmer were accepted in the show: a cast "k" metal hairpin and eardrops, a cast silver pin with pearl, and a cast pin with amethyst and pearl.

The exhibition, which will run through Dec. 18, also contains weaving, ceramics, macrame, wood and metals.
