MISSOULA, Mont.---

Two men have been appointed to positions in the business office at the University of Montana.

They are William J. Taylor, 38, treasurer, and Kendall D. Hubbard, 33, UM Foundation accountant. Both are assisting C.L. Murphy, UM business manager, in the University's financial operations.

Taylor, who received his bachelor's degree in business administration at the University of Missouri, Columbia, in 1958, formerly was employed with Haynes Inc., Bozeman, Mont. He was with that firm over 10 years.

Hubbard, a 1957 graduate of St. Olaf College, Northfield, Minn., with a bachelor's degree in economics and chemistry, previously was employed by Morgen & Oswood Construction of Great Falls, Mont. He was with that firm six years and before that had 18 months accounting experience with Terry Chevrolet, Glasgow, Mont. In 1959-60 Hubbard worked for Haggerty-Mesmer Construction, Bozeman.

Taylor is a native of Steelville, Mo. As a youth, he attended school at Cuba, Mo., and Steelville before going to the University in Columbia. Taylor is married to the former Pauline Kentopp of Falls City, Nebr. The couple has two children--Nancy Jean, 5, and Harold Joseph, 3.

Hubbard is a native of Glendive, Mont., and he attended grade and high school at Wolf Point, Mont. He is married to the former Shirley A. Seibert of Wolf Point and the couple has a son, Samuel Todd, 8.

Taylor served four years with the Navy in the Pacific area from 1951-55. Hubbard is a member of the B.P.O.E. (Elks) and the Lions Club.
