SKIING IS FEATURE
OF LAW INSTITUTE
JAN. 8-11 AT WHITEFISH

MISSOULA, Mont.---

Skiing will be the main recreational activity Jan. 8-11 when lawyers, bankers and other businessmen from several states meet at Big Mountain Ski Resort near Whitefish, Mont., for the Uniform Commercial Code (UCC) Institute.

The four-day program is part of Continuing Legal Education--Montana (CLEM), which is sponsored through the University of Montana School of Law and the Montana Bar Association. Advanced registrants include bankers and lawyers from Washington State, South Dakota and Montana.

Several well known speakers from the law profession are among those scheduled to discuss various segments of the UCC.

The speakers will include Glenn R. Coates, lawyer, Racine, Wisc.; Carl Felsenfeld, assistant general counsel of C.I.T. Corporation, New York City; William R. Klaus and Fairfax Leary Jr., attorneys, Philadelphia, Pa.; Donald J. Rapson, lawyer, Ashbury Park, N.J., and Roy L. Steinheimer Jr., attorney, New York City, who also is dean of the law school at Washington and Lee University, Lexington, Va.

Coates, Klaus and Steinheimer were featured in previous UCC conferences in Montana in 1964.

Conference sessions Jan. 8-11 are scheduled from 8:30-11 a.m. and from 4-6:30 p.m. to allow time between 11 a.m. and 4 p.m. for skiing.

Registration for the four-day program will be Jan. 7. First session will be the program introduction at 8:30 a.m. Jan. 8 by Klaus and Robert E. Sullivan, dean of the UM School of Law.

Living accommodations will be available at the Lodge and Chalet on Big Mountain and also at the Viking Lodge Motel in Whitefish. Those attending may contact either place to register in advance for accommodations.

UCC regulations were adopted by the Montana Legislature in 1963. The code includes regulations on product liability, investment securities, contract rights, credit letters, bills of lading and other documents of title. The code serves as a guideline for those involved in a wide range of business dealings.
