HELENA SISTERS OF CHARITY
HAVE WORKSHOP SATURDAY

MISSOULA---

Some 60 Sisters of Charity in Helena and vicinity will participate in a one-day workshop on interpersonal relationships Saturday (Jan. 25) at St. John's Hospital, Helena.

The workshop will be conducted by Dr. R.B. Ammons and his wife, Dr. Carol H. Ammons, certified psychologists from Missoula. Dr. R.B. Ammons is a professor of psychology at the University of Montana, Missoula.

Dr. Carol Ammons said she and her husband will begin their sessions at noon and the conferences will last through the day.

"Main objective of the sessions," she said, "will be to discuss techniques used by psychologists to improve interpersonal relationships between the nuns and other residents of the Helena community."

This is the first in a series of programs scheduled by the Sisters of Charity in Helena to implement their International General Renewal Program, utilized by the sisters to keep abreast of the times.
