MANNING RECITAL IS SLATED SUNDAY

William Manning, clarinetist, will give a recital Sunday (Feb. 2) at 8:15 p.m. in the University of Montana Recital Hall. He will be assisted by faculty colleagues Rudolph Wendt, pianist; Jane Lea, soprano, and Edwin Rosenkranz.

The free concert consists of works by Handel, Spohr, Schumann, Poulenc and Martinu.

The recital will be Manning's first since returning to the University faculty this fall after a year's leave of absence to work toward a doctorate at the University of Iowa. He joined the UM Music Department in 1957 after having earned bachelor and master degrees from Drake University and having taught in Iowa public schools.

Manning has performed throughout Montana as a clarinet soloist, a guest conductor and a clinician. He is a member of the Missoula Symphony Orchestra and is active in professional organizations.
