TAYLOR TO DISCUSS
"REVOLUTION" ON CAMPUS

Dr. Norman E. Taylor, vice president for research at the University of Montana, will discuss "Revolution on The American Campus" at a noon meeting Thursday (Feb. 20) at the Lutheran Center, 532 University Ave.

Rev. Jon Nelson, Lutheran campus pastor, said the meeting is open to the public without charge as part of a continuing program of campus and community dialogue.
