Soprano Heidi Syroid, Missoula, will sing "Ach, ich fühl's" by Mozart, and soprano Betty Woodland, a graduate student, will sing "Un bel di" by Puccini.

Pianist Mitzi Kolar, Geyser, will perform Mozart's Sonate, K. 457. A trio comprised of Linda Vogel, Bozeman, oboe; Miss Akin, harpsichord, and Kenneth Grant, Missoula, cello, will play Vivaldi's Sonata in A minor.
