Deadline for filing applications for the summer work-study program at the University of Montana is April 1.

Donald J. Mullen, UM financial aids director, said those eligible for the program include a number of UM students planning to return to classes next fall and graduating high school seniors who plan on continuing their studies.

The program is part of the statewide cooperative work-study program, whereby needy students attending any institution of higher learning in the state and qualified high school seniors can work for qualified employers in Montana full time during the summer.

Work-study applications may be obtained from Mullen's office, room 209 Main Hall at UM, or from any high school counselor or any financial aids officer at other colleges and universities in the state.

UM, Montana State University, Bozeman, and Carroll College, Helena, were the three institutions of higher learning represented recently on the Missoula campus during a financial aids workshop. Employers, prospective employers and high school counselors were also on hand for the workshop.
