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Spring break set for University of Montana students; classes resume April 1

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SPRING BREAK SET
FOR UM STUDENTS;
CLASSES RESUME APRIL 1

After a busy week of final examinations, University of Montana students will get a much-welcomed spring break before classes resume for spring quarter April 1.

Official vacation from classes begins with completion of exams Friday (March 21), but many students headed for home and other choice vacation spots earlier this week after they finished their final tests.

Spring quarter registration is set for March 31 and classes get under way the following day.

Registrar Leo Smith said a total of 4,924 have preregistered for spring quarter at UM, including 132 law students attending the University under the semester system.

"The 4,924 who already have preregistered represents about 63 per cent of the enrollment we anticipate for spring quarter," Smith said. "We expect about 6,650 for the quarter."

If 6,650 students do enroll, that figure will represent a gain of 751 students compared with the 5,899 gross enrollment from spring quarter last year, an increase of more than 12 per cent.

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
