AFROTC COMMISSIONS

MISSOULA, Mont.---

Four graduating seniors at the University of Montana here have been commissioned second lieutenants in the Air Force Reserve.

Commissionees include Gary L. Pahl, son of Mr. and Mrs. Reinhold Pahl, Timber Lake, S.D.; Charles H. Philp, son of Mr. and Mrs. W. Charles Philp Jr., Suffolk, Mont.; Roger R. Reichman, son of Mr. and Mrs. Warren N. Reichman, Ennis, Mont., and Philip H. Foley, son of Dr. and Mrs. H.E. Foley, Palo Alto, Calif.

Lt. Pahl, whose wife is the former Laurie A. Willey of Deer Lodge, Mont., was selected as a distinguished graduate of the Air Force ROTC program at UM. He was graduated with honors for his academic achievements while in college and received an AFROTC scholarship to study at the University for two years.

Lt. Pahl, who attended Timber Lake Public High School, is slated to undergo pilot training at Moody Air Force Base, Ga.
