HOOK PAINTING WINS
CALIFORNIA PRIZE

Walter Hook of the University of Montana art faculty has been awarded one of six prizes at the 3rd Biennial National Membership Exhibition of the California National Water Color Society. The exhibition is currently at the Laguna Beach, Calif., Art Galleries.

Hook's painting, a watercolor of eggs entitled "AA Large," was also selected for a two-year touring exhibition, which will start from the Virginia Museum, Richmond, Va.

Another of the Montana painter's watercolors, "Orange Street," has been selected from the 4th Biennial Exhibition of Intermountain Painting and Sculpture for inclusion in a one-year touring exhibition through the Rocky Mountain states. The parent exhibition was in the Salt Lake Art Center, Salt Lake City, Utah.
