LOENDORF RECEIVES
\$2,900 FELLOWSHIP
FROM U OF MISSOURI

MISSOULA--

Lawrence L. Loendorf, an anthropology instructor at the University of Montana here, has received a \$2,900 teaching fellowship grant from the University of Missouri, Columbia, to begin working on his doctorate during the 1969-70 academic year.

Loendorf, a 27-year-old Billings native who received his bachelor's degree in 1965 and his master's degree in anthropology in 1967 at Montana, also will receive a \$600 fellowship award from Missouri as a study stipend for several summers. He will be an assistant instructor at Missouri.

The doctoral dissertation to be written by Loendorf will deal with his research in the Pryor Mountain area south of Billings, where he and associate researchers have uncovered numerous archeological sites dating back several thousand years.

A number of stone tools of Indian manufacture were among the artifacts found by Loendorf and his field party last summer. The group will return to the Pryor Mountain area this summer to continue their search for archeological sites.

Loendorf, who was graduated from Billings Senior High School in 1959, is married to the former M. Jane Minter of Milwaukee, Wisc. The couple has two children, a daughter, Sara Jane, 5, and a son, Christopher Ronald, 3. Mrs. Loendorf is daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Harry Minter, who now live in Itasca, Ill.
