SMOKER, BARRISTERS' BANQUET  
INCLUDED IN UM LAW WEEKEND

A smoker and the Barristers' Banquet and Ball sponsored by the University of Montana Student Bar Association (SBA) will highlight Law Weekend activities here Friday and Saturday.

This year Law Weekend is being held in conjunction with the spring conference on Continuing Legal Education--Montana (CLEM), a continuing law study and review program cosponsored by the UM School of Law and the Montana Bar Association. Theme of the CLEM conference is "Product Liability and Other Recent Developments."

The student smoker is scheduled for 8 p.m. Friday at the Florence Hotel. The Barristers' Banquet will be at 8 p.m. Saturday at the Missoula Elks Club. The Barristers' Ball follows the banquet at the club. A social hour precedes the banquet beginning at 6:30 p.m. Saturday.

Scholarships and other awards will be presented to UM law students during Saturday's banquet.

Late registration for both Law Weekend and the CLEM spring conference will be at 8:15 a.m. Friday at the Yellowstone Room of the campus Lodge, where formal CLEM sessions are scheduled. Information will be available at the registration desk concerning five-year class reunions commemorating the 5th through 35th years of graduation from the UM School of Law.

During a session from 9 a.m.-noon Saturday, Melvin M. Belli, a noted California attorney, will discuss "Aspects of Product Liability." CLEM conference closing remarks are scheduled at noon.
