Priscilla Eitel, harpist, will give a free recital Tuesday (May 13) at 8:15 p.m. in the University of Montana Recital Hall.

She will be assisted by Charles Bolen, flutist, and Eugene Weigel, violist, in Debussy's Sonate for Viola, Flute and Harp. She will perform solo works by Handel, Saint-Saens, Pierne and Grandjany.

Mrs. Eitel teaches harp at the University and in the Missoula public schools. She earned a bachelor of music degree in harp and theory from Eastman School of Music and did graduate work at Macalester College in Minnesota. She has taught harp at the University of Michigan, Ann Arbor, and the National Music Camp, Interlochen, Mich. She has been harpist and soloist with the Minneapolis Civic Orchestra.
