UM SINGING GROUP  
TO ENTERTAIN ALUMNI  
AFTER G.E. COLLEGE BOWL

MISSOULA, Mont.---

University of Montana (UM) alumni in the New York City area will be in for a special treat Sunday (May 18) following the General Electric College Bowl appearance of a four-man team from the University.

A dozen University of Montana singing Jubileers will perform for the alumni at the Tin Lizzie Restaurant in New York following the 6 p.m. (EDT) College Bowl broadcast.

Dr. Joseph A. Mussulman, an associate professor of music at UM, is Jubileeer director. He is accompanying the group.

Sunday's College Bowl broadcast by the NBC-TV Network is scheduled to be shown locally at 4 p.m. (MDT) on KGVO-TV and by cable at 7 p.m. (MDT) on KHQ-TV.

The Jubileers from Montana completed a USO entertainment tour of military bases in the Northeast Command this week. They will enplane at Kennedy Field May 19 for a flight to London, where they begin a two-week European tour.

The four-man College Bowl team from the University of Montana will match wits and speed with a team from Lehigh University, which defeated a team from Indiana University last Sunday.

College Bowl team members from Montana include James E. Curry, a senior in history from Ekalaka; George Robert Blair, a junior in wildlife from St. Louis, Mo.; Scott Wheeler, a senior in history from Spokane, Wash., and William E. Larson, a senior in liberal arts from Great Falls. Robert M. Murdo, a senior in history and economics from Billings, is UM team alternate.

Dr. Robert T. Turner, a UM professor of history, is adviser to the UM team.

Dr. Turner and the UM team will enplane at Johnson-Bell Field west of Missoula at 10:20 a.m. Friday (Northwest Flight 104) for the trip east. The University representatives are due to arrive back at the airport at 5:53 p.m. Monday (Northwest Flight 109).

If Montana wins this Sunday's College Bowl battle, then the team will return to New York the following week to compete against a team from another college or university.
