The top 13 individual finishers in this year's Big Sky Conference golf championships have been named to all-conference first or second teams.

Jack Miller, coach of the winning University of Montana team, said that all-league teams will be named each year from now on.

The Grizzlies placed all six championship golfers on the squads, three on each. Idaho had four all-conference golfers, and Weber State, Montana State and Idaho State had one each.

Next year's championship play will change slightly. Rather than totalling only the best four scores from each team, the total will be derived from adding the top five.

First team members, with their 54-hole scores from last weekend's tournament, are Rick Carpenter, Montana, 219; Nick Fullerton, Montana State, 223; Spike Daugherty, Montana, and Mark Cooper, Idaho, 225; Skip Pierce, Idaho, 227, and Skip Kopravica, Montana, 228.

Second team members, with scores, are Eric Anderson, Idaho State, 229; Rick Spaeth, Idaho, and Glen Wysel, Montana, 231; Don Seeley, Idaho, and Steve Sullivan, Montana, 232, and Dick Kuhl, Montana, and Jim Linke, Weber State, 233.
