ARMY ROTC SPONSORS LECTURER DR. HAROLD ROOD

MISSOULA, MONT.-----Dr. Harold W. Rood, noted political theorist, will speak at the University of Montana Wednesday, May 28, at 7 p.m. in Liberal Arts 11. His topic will be "The Changing World and the Military Implications."

Rood, who received his Ph.D. from the University of California in Berkley, now serves as an associate professor in Political Science at Claremont Men's College and Graduate School. He is also an instructor in International Relations, American Foreign Policy, Military Power and Diplomacy, and other related courses.

In recent months Dr. Rood has taken part in a seminar on Vietnam at Wichita State University and has been a Guest-in-Residence at the University of California at San Diego lecturing on the American Policy in Vietnam, Nuclear Proliferation, and the Cuban Crisis.

Dr. Rood's lecture is the third in the Army ROTC Academic Enrichment Program series. His appearance on campus is sponsored jointly by ASUM Program Council and the University of Montana Army ROTC.
