BACH CONCERT SET FOR INITIATES OF HONORARY

The 1969 concert in honor of this year's new members of the University of Montana chapter of Pi Kappa Lambda music honorary will consist of works by Johann Sebastian Bach. The free program will be Tuesday (May 27) at 8:15 p.m. in the Recital Hall.

Laurence Perry, organist, will introduce the program with Toccata, Adagio, and Fugue in C Major.

Organizations performing are the Montana Little Symphony, whose director is Eugene Andrie, and the University Choir, whose director is Dr. Joseph Mussulman, now in Europe with the Jubileers. Prof. Andrie will condcut the orchestra in Concerto in d minor for piano and strings, with Linda Lee Thomas as soloist, and the orchestra and choir in Magnificat in D Major.

The latter features in vocal solos or duets Richard Nicaise, Great Falls, and Missoulians Gloria Phillip, Candice Boyer, Richard Stewart, Pearl Erny and Randy Schliebe.

Ramsey Miller and Charles Miller are assistant directors, respectively, of the orchestra and the choir.
