UM PRESIDENT PANTZER
TO ADDRESS GRADUATES,
GUESTS THIS WEEKEND

MISSOULA--

Diploma presentations and two talks by University of Montana President Robert T. Pantzer will highlight commencement activities this weekend at the University.

Pantzer will address graduating seniors, parents and other guests at the annual Senior Banquet at 6:30 p.m. Saturday in the Five Valleys Room of the new University Center. The president also will deliver the "Charge to the Graduating Class" of 1969 at the 72nd annual commencement at 2 p.m. Sunday in the Harry Adams Field House on campus.

The commencement list includes 1,334 names. Two honorary doctorates also will be presented Sunday to UM alumni-- Hugh D. Galusha Jr., formerly of Helena and now president of the Federal Reserve Bank of Minneapolis, Minn., and Dr. Herbert E. Robinson, Swift Chemical Co. president, Oak Brook, Ill., who completed high school at Ronan and who is a Henderson, Mont., native.

Other graduation activities at the University this weekend include presentation of commissions to students who have participated in the Army ROTC program.

Commissionees, relatives and friends will meet at 10 a.m. Saturday in the Music Recital Hall for the commissioning exercise.

A reception by the University for the graduating class and their relatives, alumni and friends is scheduled for 5:30 p.m. Saturday in the University Center Montana Rooms.

Commencement activities will be completed at 11 a.m. Tuesday (June 17) in the UC Montana Rooms with the commissioning of Air Force ROTC cadets.
