UM YELLOWSTONE NATIONAL PARK TOUR
SCHEDULED FOR JULY 11-13

MISSOULA--

A three-day tour of Yellowstone National Park is scheduled for July 11-13 by the University of Montana summer session.

The tour starts at the University Center at 12:30 p.m. Friday (July 11) and is slated to arrive back at the Center at 8 p.m. Sunday (July 13).

Tour fee is \$20 per person, plus meals and lodging. Tents or tarps may be used if the prearranged lodging is not desired. Tourists will be staying overnight in the West Yellowstone and Canyon City areas.

A bus will be chartered if 25 or more persons register, otherwise University cars will be used.

On the agenda are stops at the Montana State Prison, Deer Lodge; Virginia City, which is a restored ghost town, and a tour of the Earthquake Area Visitors Center on Highway 287, about 20 miles northwest of West Yellowstone. A tour of the Lewis and Clark Caverns between Butte and Three Forks also is planned.

Persons going on the tour are encouraged to bring a comfortable pair of walking shoes, shorts, slacks and a heavy jacket. Swimsuits and cameras should also be taken.

Tour registrations are being accepted at the University Center Information Desk. Registration deadline is 1 p.m. Wednesday (July 9).
