JAMES P. ALLISON
COMPLETES DOCTORAL ORAL
AT UNIVERSITY OF MONTANA

MISSOULA--

James P. Allison, son of Dr. and Mrs. M.P. Allison, Northwood, Iowa, successfully completed his doctoral oral examination in psychology at the University of Montana, Missoula, on July 3.

He will receive his doctorate in August following the completion of his written thesis involving brightness and position discriminations using rats in mazes.

Allison received his bachelor's degree at Grinnell College, Grinnell, Iowa, in 1963 and his master's degree in 1965 at the University of Montana. He will begin a teaching position this fall at Knox College, Galesburg, Ill.
