AUG. 8-10 PACK TRIP AT UM IS OPEN TO PUBLIC

MISSOULA --

A fourth all-horseback trip is being planned by the University of Montana summer session for this weekend (Aug. 8-10). Destination is Big Salmon Lake in the Bob Marshall Wilderness.

Registration is open to the public. Persons interested should meet at the University Center parking lot at 12:30 p.m. Friday (Aug. 8). The packers will return to Missoula at 8 p.m. Sunday (Aug. 10).

A \$45 fee includes cost of food, tents and horse rental. Packers should bring sleeping bags, sturdy riding clothes, comfortable walking shoes and boots, warm clothing for night, and swim suits if desired.

Buff Hultman, guide and packer at Holland Lake, will again escort the packers into and out of the wilderness.

Persons interested should prepay at the University Center Information Desk, second floor, by noon Wednesday (Aug. 6).
