ENLT 430.1 Senior Seminar: The Bible for Literature Students

Goals: to acquaint advanced students of Literature with the Hebrew Bible and the New Testament, with emphasis placed on the various ways the Bible has been understood as canonical in the West. No previous experience of the Bible is presumed. Students will demonstrate their understanding of the material and its application through a series of short papers and oral reports which will measure their ability to connect the Biblical text with multiple interpretations of its meaning.
