UM PROFESSOR RECEIVES
\$11,300 NSF GRANT
FOR COMPUTER STUDY

Dr. Robert P. Banaugh, director of the University of Montana Computer Center, has received an \$11,300 grant from the National Science Foundation to conduct a computer-related study.

Dr. Banaugh, who also is a professor and director of the UM Department of Computer Science, said the funds will be utilized during the current academic year to conduct research to obtain a more efficient digital computer solution "of a class of mathematical problems which frequently occur in physics and engineering."

The grant is a result of ideas from work done by Dr. Banaugh under a previous NSF grant.
