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### University of Montana hosts unique art exhibition

A collection of lithographs, etchings, woodcuts, silk-screens and original prints will be exhibited by London Grafica Arts Inc. in the mall of the University of Montana Student Center Wednesday, Oct. 15, from 10 a.m.-5 p.m.

The prominent touring art collection will include work by both old and contemporary masters, 19th and 20th century prints and a full selection of contemporary prints commissioned especially by London Arts.

Work by such well known artists as Rembrandt, Toulouse-Lautrec, Picasso, Renoir, Degas, Chagall and Vasarely will be represented. All pieces will be on sale, ranging in price from \$10 - \$3,000.

Featured in the exhibition are original graphic prints. This means that the work has been printed directly from the plate or stone that the artist himself has done.

The normal practice is to make an "edition" of between 20 and 125 numbered and signed impressions of any one work before destroying the plate from which it has been printed. Thus, the print is not as unique an item as a painting. However, the work still retains a definite degree of exclusiveness.

Approximately 500 of these original works will be displayed, spanning a wide range of print history from 16th century manuscript pages to such modern masters as Picasso and Braque.

A London Arts representative will be available throughout the exhibition to answer any questions about the prints or graphic arts in general.

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
