RECITAL IS TUESDAY

MISSOULA---

Janet Boyer Kenney, soprano, will present her senior recital Tuesday (Dec. 9) at the University of Montana.

Mrs. Kenney will be accompanied by Fredericka Marie Ibsen, Missoula, on the piano, along with the Montana Little Symphony, conducted by Eugene Andrie, a UM music professor.

The recital, which is open to the public without charge, will be at 8:15 p.m. in the UM Music Recital Hall.

The recital will include works by Bach, Berlioz, Berlinski and Mozart.

A student of John L. Lester, a UM music professor, Mrs. Kenney also has studied under Tod Duncan in Washington, D.C. Duncan was one of the nation's most outstanding Negro baritones several decades ago. In later years he has been a voice instructor.

Mrs. Kenney has sung lead roles in the UM productions of "Pagliacci," "The Magic Flute" and "Susannah." Her professional experience includes / ^{works} with the Washington Opera Society, solo work with the Washington Hebrew Congregation, radio-TV commercials and solo experience with the Bob Cross Orchestra in Washington, D.C.

Among other performances, Mrs. Kenney has sung before such dignitaries as Richard M. Nixon and Hubert H. Humphrey.

Mrs. Kenney is the daughter of the late Marion Boyer of Missoula and Martin Boyer, who lives in Chicago, Ill. Her recital partially fulfills requirements for the Bachelor of Music degree in applied music.
