FOUR FROM UM
TO ATTEND STUDENT
PRESIDENTS MEETING
IN HELENA SAT.

MISSOULA---

Four University of Montana students will participate Saturday in a meeting of the Montana Student Presidents Association (MSPA) in Helena.

The meeting will be hosted by Carroll College. Registration is from 10 a.m. to noon. First formal session gets under way at 1 p.m. in the college student union.

The MSPA is composed of the student body presidents of public and private colleges and universities in Montana.

Representing the University of Montana at the meeting will be Joseph P. Mazurek, Helena, president of the Associated Students of UM (ASUM); Gary J. Thogersen, Sidney, ASUM vice-president; Robert K. Strong, St. Ignatius, a junior delegate to Central Board, the UM student governing body, and John N. Hanson, Winnett, sophomore delegate to Central Board,

Strong is a candidate for the post of state coordinator for the 19-year-old vote campaign. The coordinator will be elected at Saturday's meeting.

Topics scheduled for discussion at the MSPA meeting include one which would permit the State Youth Council to work with the governor's Human Resources Council.

Also scheduled is a discussion concerning a request to the Council of Presidents to allow college and university students to vote on issues involving any increases in building fees for the purposes of remodeling old buildings or building new ones on various campuses across the state.

The Council of Presidents is composed of the presidents of the six units of the Montana University System.

Mazurek said the 12th member of the MSPA, Dawson College of Glendive, will be welcomed into the MSPA at Saturday's meeting.
