DEC. 8-12 AT UM

More than 100 art objects will be on sale next week at the University of Montana during the semiannual Silent Art Auction.

The sale will include paintings, sculpture, graphics and ceramics, all done by University undergraduate and graduate students.

Auction hours will be from 8 a.m. to midnight Dec. 8-11 and from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. Friday, Dec. 12, at the University Center Gallery.

Douglas Grimm, Missoula, a UM graduate student in art and the art show director, said the items will be purchased by writing bids on forms attached to each art object.

"The person who has bid the most for a particular item by 6 p.m. Friday will be awarded the object for the price bid," said Grimm. He said bidding probably would be the greatest during the last few hours of the sale Dec. 12.

The auction is sponsored by the Program Council of the Associated Students at UM and the Student Art Organization.
