FILMS OF BLACK LIBERATION  
TO BE SHOWN AT UM

MISSOULA---

"Newsreel Program I-Black Liberation," a series of short film clips, will be shown at the University of Montana Tuesday (Jan. 6).

The presentation, sponsored by the Associated Students of UM Program Council, is scheduled for 9:15 p.m. in the University Center (UC) Ballroom.

The program includes "Black Panther," in which Bobby Seale lays out the 10-point program of the Panthers and "May Day 1969," which is a film of the Panthers' rally at San Francisco's Federal Building in honor of Huey Newton, their imprisoned leader.

Also included will be "Strike City," which deals with plantation workers in Mississippi, "Nossa Terra," a film of the war of independence in Portuguese Guinea, "Riot Control Weapons," and "Now," which concludes that militant action is the only alternative in fighting for self-determination.

The newsreel program was produced to serve as a medium of agitation, diffusion and exchange of revolutionary experiences.

Tickets will be on sale at the UC Ballroom entrance for Tuesday's showing.
