FINE ARTS CLASSES FOR KIDS
START JAN. 17 AT UM

MISSOULA---

A series^{of}/eight two-hour fine arts classes for Missoula area youngsters gets under way Jan. 17 at the University of Montana.

The program, which is under the direction of Richard B. Reinholtz, an associate professor of art at UM, will encompass various art subjects including ceramics, music, drama, creative writing and painting.

Teaching will be done by more than 30 University students who are members of an undergraduate art class ^{taught} by Reinholtz, Art for Elementary Teachers.

Class hours beginning Jan. 17 will be from 9:30-11:30 a.m. at a cost of 50 cents per class. Each two-hour session will have several different fine arts programs scheduled.

Youngsters participating in the program may be from ages 5 through 14 or between kindergarten and eighth grade.
