Hugh D. Galusha Jr., president of the Federal Reserve Bank of Minneapolis, Minn., will speak Thursday (Feb. 5) at the University of Montana.

The former Helena attorney will address students, faculty and the general public at a meeting slated for 3:15 p.m. in room 215 of the UM Women's Center.
