KURT MILLER TO SERVE
ON MUSIC WORKSHOP FACULTY
AUG. 10-21 AT SAN JOSE STATE

MISSOULA, Mont.--

Dr. Kurt Miller, an associate professor of music at the University of Montana, will serve on the faculty of the Workshop in Comprehensive Musicianship for School Music Teachers Aug. 10-21 in California.

The workshop, to be held under the Contemporary Music Project auspices, is a project of the Music Educators' National Conference and will be financed with a grant from the Ford Foundation.

Goal of the two-week program, which will be at San Jose State College, San Jose, Calif., is to acquaint teachers with the principles of comprehensive musicianship which will enable the student to make independent value judgments about music as a listener, performer and creator.

Dr. Miller, who joined the UM faculty in 1967, is coauthor of the textbook "Help Yourself to Music." Before coming to Missoula he was music and art supervisor in several California public school districts.

From 1958-62 Dr. Miller was the director of music for the U.S. Army's dependents' schools in Europe.
