- Students must have a reed knife, mandrel, file & reamer (bassoon only), sharpening stone, plaque, wire and/or thread, sand paper, and cane for the semester

**Upon completion of this course, the student will be able to:**

- Understand the process of preparing cane
- Understand the process of shaping cane (oboe players only)
- Be able to tie/wrap a reed blank
- Be able to scrape/file a reed blank
- Understand the technique of finishing a reed for performance

**Weekly Assignment:**

- It is expected that each student will tie/wrap three-five reed blanks each week
- It is expected that each student will attempt to scrape the three-five reed blanks each week
