MRS. SWANSON APPOINTED TO BUSINESS
EDUCATION STEERING COMMITTEE;
TO MEET IN HELENA

MISSOULA--

Mrs. Margaret A. Swanson, associate professor of business education and administration at the University of Montana, has been appointed to a steering committee for the development of business education guidelines for Montana high schools.

She was appointed to the committee by Mrs. Dolores Colburg, state superintendent of public instruction.

Mrs. Swanson said the six-member steering committee will meet in Helena March 13-14 to formulate functional plans for developing a statement of business education philosophy, suggested standards, curriculum development, and requirements of vocational teachers for Federally reimbursed programs.

Mrs. Swanson said absolute standards will be formulated at a workshop this summer from the business education guidelines established by the steering committee. The summer workshop will be for high school teachers.

Dr. Donald B. Koeppen, chairman of business education and office administration at UM, will participate in the steering committee's weekend meeting in Helena.
