U OF COLORADO DIRECTOR OF ADMISSIONS NAMED TO SUCCEED SMITH AS UM REGISTRAR

MISSOULA --

Wayne C. Woolston, director of admissions and records at the University of Colorado Colorado Springs Center, will become registrar at the University of Montana on July 1, UM President Robert T. Pantzer announced today.

Woolston, 38, will succeed Leo Smith, who will retire in June after 24 years of service at UM. Smith became resistrar in 1946 and has taught extensively in the School of Education.

"Leo Smith has been a diligent, loyal staff member on this campus these many years,"

Pantzer commented. "He has effectively served the University as registrar and professor in the School of Education. His service has been truly outstanding."

Woolston, a native of Inglewood, Calif., has been director of admissions and records at the Colorado Springs Center since 1965. He also was a lecturer there in education from 1965 to 1967.

The new registrar has also held positions as assistant administrator, Colorado Springs Center (1961 to 1965); director of guidance and special education, Moffat County School District, Craig, Colo. (1957 to 1961).

Colorado State College, Greeley, awarded Woolston a bachelor of arts degree in 1954 and a master of arts degree in 1957. He is a member of Phi Delta Kappa, the American Association of Collegiate Registrars and Admission Officers; the Colorado-Wyoming Association of Collegiate Registrars and Admission Officers, and the National Association of Student Personnel Administrators.

He served in the U.S. Army from 1954 to 1956.

Woolston and his wife, Joyce, have three children, David, 15, Kenneth, 12, and Steven, 9.

A native of Browning, Mo., Smith received a bachelor of science degree in chemistry from Whitman College, Walla Walla, Wash., in 1927, and a master of arts degree in education administration from the University of Washington, Seattle, in 1934.

He worked in high school administrative work and vocational education in Montana towns including Glendive, Sidney and Great Falls. Prior to his appointment as UM registrar, he served as State Supervisor of Distributive Education and Occupational Information and Guidance for three years.

He also served for several years as state coordinator of the American College Testing Program. He is a member of the Missoula Kiwanis Club and the Masonic Lodge.
