The University of Montana tennis team travels to Bozeman to take on Montana State University and Eastern Montana this Saturday.

Montana has not met Eastern Montana but white-washed the Bobcats in the only meeting of the season, 9-0.

UM coach Jack McWhorter said the Grizzlies lost number two singles player Dirk Miller due to some pulled muscles. Miller will be out this week but should be back in action next week for the Inland Empire matches in Pullman, Wash.

The 2-2 Grizzlies will have Rick Ferrell in the number one spot, Fred King, two, Chris Greene, three, Gary Israel, four, Al Shiotsuka, five and Steve Greene will move in the number six position.
