MISSOULA--

Saturday is the final test of the season for the University of Montana track team and the last meet of Roy Robinson's career.

Robinson will hang up the spikes after the Big Sky Championship at Ogden, Utah, unless he qualifies for the NCAA finals. He will devote his full time to professional football and the Atlanta Falcons, the team that drafted him.

Robinson came to the Missoula university after a tremendous high school football and track career at Glasgow High School. He was king of the sprints and high and low hurdles in prep competition. Robinson still holds the Montana 120-yard high hurdles and the Class A high and low hurdle records.

As a Grizzly, Robinson has tied the school record in the high hurdles and the 100-yard dash and won the Big Sky title in both events. He has been clocked at 9.4 seconds in the century and 14.1 in the hurdles. Robinson holds five dual meet records at UM.

In his junior and senior years as a Grizzly, Robinson has been defeated only once in the high hurdles and is undefeated in the 100. Central Washington's John Kirry defeated Robinson in 1969, but in 1970 the UM senior ran away from the Wildcat hurdler. He is 18-1 in the events.

In football Robinson was an All-Big Sky cornerback and was selected to the NCAA All-District 6 first unit.

He was selected by Atlanta in the ninth round of the pro football draft and will report to the Falcons this summer.
