MISSOULA--

The appointment of Michael Frellick as assistant director of admissions for the University of Montana has been announced by Jack L. Hoover, director of admissions.

Frellick, who has been with the UM Foundation since February, 1969, will assume his new duties on July 1.

In describing the new UM position, Hoover said Frellick will have responsibility for counseling with high school and transfer students who come to the campus; representing the University at college programs held by Montana high schools; coordinating special programs and projects involving prospective students, and arranging campus tours for both individuals and groups.

Born in Okmulgee, Okla. in 1944, Frellick is a graduate of Great Falls Public High School and the University of Montana.

He joined the UM Foundation as coordinator of the Montana Center for the Arts, and since July of 1969 has served as director of special projects for the Foundation.

Frellick presently is a member of the Montana National Guard at Ft. Missoula. He also is affiliated with Sigma Nu fraternity.

Frellick's parents, Mr. and Mrs. J. P. Frellick, are residents of Great Falls.
