SET FOR JUNE 20
AT U OF MONTANA

MISSOULA-----

The University of Montana Summer Session will sponsor a tour of several western Montana ghost towns June 20.

The one-day tour is open to the general public as well as UM Summer Session faculty, staff, students and their families. Departure time will be 7 a.m. from the University Center. Arrival time back in Missoula is set for 9 p.m.

The no-academic-credit tour will include stops at Garnet, Granite, Southern Cross and Cable. The itinerary also includes a brief stop in Philipsburg at 11:30 a.m.

Registration forms for the tour are available at the University Center Information Desk. All registrations must be in by June 17.

A number of University vehicles will be available for those who do not have other transportation. Persons bringing cars are asked to provide rides for those not riding in University cars. Riders will be required to pay \$5 traveling expenses to the driver of the car.

Participants have been asked to bring a sack lunch to eat in Granite at 12:30 p.m. Dinner will be at the Marcus Daly Hotel in Anaconda at 5:30 p.m. The charge for the dinner will be \$2.50.

Dr. Walter C. Schwank, who is UM Summer Session director and chairman of the Department of Health, Physical Education and Recreation, advises participants to wear shoes and bring warm jackets. Registration forms are available in room 219 of the Field House.
