3,300 EXPECTED FOR UM SUMMER SESSION JUNE 15-AUGUST 14

MISSOULA --

Approximately 3,300 are expected to enroll at the University of Montana for summer session next week, Mrs. Emma B. Lommasson, UM assistant registrar said Wednesday.

An increase of at least 375 over last summer's enrollment of 2,925 is anticipated, she said.

Summer session will include a nine week session, June 15-August 14, and two 4½-week sessions, June 15-July 15 and July 16-August 14.

Students planning to enroll in the first 4½-week summer session who have not already notified the registrar's office should do so immediately. Registration packets will be available during the week. Students who have already ordered packets may pick them up on Monday (June 15) in room 205 in Main Hall.

Registration directions and schedule changes are available with the registration packets.

"Due to changes in faculty, class hours and courses since the summer session catalog was printed," said Mrs. Lommasson, "students should check the schedule changes carefully before making final enrollment plans."

Registration must be completed during the first week of the session in which the student enrolls. The deadline is Friday of the first week (June 19).

Students should attend class the first day of instruction and work out scheduling problems and complete registration during free periods.

Completed packets, with signatures of each instructor, should be taken to 205 Main Hall. Registration is not complete until fees are paid and cards are checked, Mrs.

Lommasson said. ###
