TO BE IN UM RECITAL  
ON TUESDAY, JUNE 23

MISSOULA-----

Ann Bolen, a 15-year-old Missoula violinist, will be featured with her father in a recital at the University of Montana at 8:15 p.m. Tuesday, June 23, in the UM Music Recital Hall.

Appearing on the same program as flute soloist will be Dr. Charles W. Bolen, Miss Bolen's father, who is dean of the School of Fine Arts at the University of Montana, Missoula.

Father and daughter are well known performers, but this is the first time both have appeared on the same program as soloists.

Miss Bolen won the Billings Concerto Competition last year and appeared as soloist with Billings Symphony. She has been soloist with the University of Montana orchestra and the Missoula High School orchestra, where she is concert mistress.

While attending the National Music Camp at Interlochen, Mich., the past two summers, Miss Bolen was among the top violinists in the World Symphony.

Assisting in the program will be Rudolph Wendt, piano, and Eugene Andrie, viola, both University of Montana music professors. Also performing with the soloists will be Karen Andrie, cellist, daughter of Professor Andrie, and Jeff Showell, a recent graduate of Sentinel High School, who plays the viola.

Miss Andrie had a Fullbright grant to study cello in Europe, where she was soloist with several European orchestras. She is presently cellist with the Syracuse Symphony. This coming year she will perform with the Atlanta Symphony.
