The Shaffer Memorial Fund has been established by the University of Montana Alumni Association Development Fund in memory of a UM student who died in a Missoula bicycle mishap this spring.

George Oechsli (pronounced Oxlee), director of the Alumni Association Development Fund, said the new memorial is in honor of the late James A. Shaffer, 23, who died from injuries received in a bike accident May 19 in downtown Missoula.

Oechsli said a request for establishment of the memorial fund was made recently by Shaffer's parents, Mr. and Mrs. James A. Shaffer Jr., Rossmoor, Calif., to aid needy and deserving students at the University.

Other survivors of the deceased UM student include relatives in Butte and Polson, Mont.
