UNIVERSITY PROHIBITS USE OF FIREWORKS
IN MARRIED STUDENT HOUSING

MISSOULA--

Several recent incidents involving the use of fireworks in the University of Montana married student housing area have prompted University officials to call attention to a long-standing policy prohibiting the use of fireworks by anyone on UM property, including family housing.

University officials said that firecrackers being thrown at children and cars, dropped along walkways in the area and discharged in the playgrounds and on the rapidly drying mountain slopes have caused the danger of injury to the many small children in the area and the danger of a serious fire on the mountainside.

A letter has been sent to all married housing residents asking them to cooperate with the University and the Family Housing Committee in adhering to this policy.
