## **Grading:**

Evaluation in this course will be based upon:

  - (1) An illness narrative. Paper due by end of class on September 20. (10 %)
  - (2) Analysis of a selected work. Paper due by end of class on October 18. (15 %)
  - (3) Analysis of a course theme. Paper due by end of class on November 15. (15%)
  - (4) Final exam. Paper due by 5.00 PM on Tuesday, December 18. (20 %)
- class participation (30 %). Because this course employs a seminar-discussion format, all students will be expected to participate actively in class discussions. The success of the course will depend on a free and vigorous, challenging and provocative exchange of ideas among the students and the instructor (who is a student, simply a few miles farther along the road). In discussing any literary work, remember that there is no single “right answer.”
