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## Registration scheduled July 16 at UM for second summer session

Registration for the second 4½-week Summer Session at the University of Montana is scheduled for Thursday (July 16). The first session ends Wednesday (July 15).

Summer school enrollment so far is 2,772, according to Mrs. Emma B. Lommasson, UM assistant registrar. Total enrollment is expected to reach 2,925 during the second session.

Students intending to register for the session are expected to attend classes July 16 and pick up their registration packets during their free hours that day in Main Hall 205.

During this 4½-week session the UM School of Education will offer a remedial reading program for students in grades 1 through 12. Special classes will be held for college students and high school students who expect to attend college.

The remedial reading classes will consist of one to four students each, said Dr. James J. Munro, education professor at UM, who is director of the Summer School Reading Laboratory. Experienced teachers will handle the classes.

The advanced program for college and high school students will include instructions on taking notes in class, studying textbooks, improving reading speed and comprehension, and preparing for examinations.

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
