UM MATH TEACHER
GETS OKAY ON
\$11,000 STUDY GRANT

MISSOULA.....

The Montana Congressional delegation has been advised of an \$11,000 grant to a University of Montana faculty member from the National Science Foundation for a study in mathematics.

In a telegram to UM President Robert T. Pantzer, Sen. Mike Mansfield said the award to Dr. Michael J. Fisher, an assistant professor of mathematics on the Missoula campus, recently was approved by the NSF for a study entitled "Applications of Fractional Powers of Operators."

Dr. Fisher explained the 24-month grant will involve "the study of several concrete problems in functional analysis in mathematics."

The NSF study grant will be presented through the University of Montana Foundation.
