Three University of Montana music groups will give programs in public schools next week, according to Donald A. Carey, assistant professor of music and Montana coordinator for Young Audiences, Inc.

The tours by the Music Theater Quintet, the Montana Chamber Players and the Montana String Quartet are sponsored by Young Audiences, Inc. Carey said the national nonprofit organization was started 20 years ago to introduce grade-school children to good music performed by musicians of professional caliber.

Costs are shared by Young Audiences, Inc., and the schools in which programs are presented, Carey said. Tours also receive support from the Montana Arts Council.

The Music Theater Quintet will sing Monday (Sept. 14) in Philipsburg and Anaconda, Tuesday in Helena, and Wednesday in East Helena, Townsend and Three Forks. Members are John L. Lester, acting dean of the UM School of Fine Arts and director of the quintet; Esther England, instructor in music, and students Nick Alex, Hingham, and Adrienne Dussault and Randy Schliebe, both of Missoula. Freddi Ibsen, Missoula, is piano accompanist.

The Montana Chamber Players will perform Tuesday (Sept. 15) in Conrad, Valier and Chester; Wednesday in Havre and Big Sandy, and Thursday and Friday in Great Falls. The performers, members of the music faculty, are Jerry Domer, oboist; Edwin Rosenkranz, bassoonist, and Lucien Hut, pianist.

The Montana String Quartet will perform Friday (Sept. 18) in Whitefish, Polson and Ronan. The faculty quartet is comprised of Eugene Andrie and Gerald Doty, violinists; Gordon Childs, violist, and Florence Reynolds, cellist.
