UM TO HOST  
MEDICAL PROGRAM  
SEPT. 14-18

MISSOULA--

The University of Montana will host a workshop Sept. 14-18 dealing with the use of enzymes in clinical medicine and the distributions of lipid proteins as found in the detection of various heart diseases.

Directors of the program for medical technicians and laboratory personnel are Dr. Galen P. Mell, an assistant professor of chemistry, and Dr. Walter L. Koostra, an assistant professor of microbiology at UM.

"The five-day refresher course is part of a continuing education program for medical personnel," Dr. Mell said. "The program will be particularly valuable to the medical participants because of the continual changes in medical methodology, and the application of enzymes or biological catalysts in diagnosing various diseases such as liver and heart ailments and cancer."

Program registration will be at 9 a.m. Monday in room 411 of the UM Health Sciences Building. Classes will run from 9 a.m.-5 p.m. Monday through Friday. Registration fee is \$22.50.

The workshop is sponsored by the Montana Education and Research Foundation, the Montana Division of the Western Interstate Commission for Higher Education-- Mountain States Regional Medical Program, and the Montana Society of Medical Technologists.
