PRES. PANTZER TO WELCOME
NEW STUDENTS, PARENTS
SUNDAY AT U OF MONTANA

MISSOULA--

University of Montana President Robert T. Pantzer and other University administrators and faculty members will welcome new students and their parents to the Missoula campus at the President's Reception Sunday (Sept. 20).

Sunday's reception will be from 3 to 5 p.m. in the Five Valleys Room in the University Center (UC).

Other activities Sunday include a no-host luncheon for new students and parents in the Lodge at 12:30 p.m., and the President's Convocation for Parents at 2 p.m. in the University Theater (UT).

The President's Convocation for all new students will be at 7 p.m. Sunday in the UT. Jack L. Green, president of the Associated Students of UM, who is chairman of the UM Orientation Committee, will be master of ceremonies and will give instructions on formation of orientation groups during the program.

Sunday's reception at 3 p.m. in the UC will enable new students and parents to visit with UM deans, departments heads and other faculty and staff.

Among those in the receiving line will be Mr. and Mrs. Pantzer, Dr. and Mrs. Richard G. Landini, Mr. and Mrs. George L. Mitchell and Dr. and Mrs. Norman E. Taylor. Dr. Landini is academic vice-president, Mitchell is administrative vice-president and Dr. Taylor is vice-president for research at UM.

New students will assemble at 9 a.m. Monday in their respective homerooms for organization of orientation groups.

Classes begin Thursday (Sept. 24) on the Missoula campus. Freshmen and transfer students register from 8 a.m.-3 p.m. Tuesday. Former students register from 3-5 p.m. Tuesday and from 8 a.m.-5 p.m. Wednesday.
